

Litter and Cigarette Control at University of Glasgow - Faculty of Veterinary Medicine



PROBLEM IDENTIFIED

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Glasgow is located in an area susceptible to very bad weather conditions. Open-topped, cast-iron litter containers and separate cigarette waste units were originally sited at building entrances and on walkways, but litter was blown out of the bins in high winds and they became water-logged following heavy rain. The cast-iron litter bins also needed regular maintenance and painting due to weather damage.

A corrosion and weather-resistant litter container was required to cut down on maintenance costs. A hooded container would also prevent the bins from becoming water-logged and litter being blown around the site.

INTEGRO is manufactured from hard-wearing Durapol®* material and incorporates an integral stainless steel stubber plate and grille. The high quality materials ensure that it is weather and corrosion-resistant, and so requires minimum maintenance. The hooded design also keeps litter in its place and protects the contents from rain. For quick and easy siting, the Bins were supplied with internal ballast to provide a secure container with no fixing requirements.
